In the reference letter 1st and 2nd cited, instructions have already been given regarding Dengue awareness and action to be taken to prevent Dengue fever. In continuation to that there are Clustering of fever cases including dengue are noticed in schools in Dharmapuri, Thiruvallur, Tirunelveli, Kancheepuram and Chennai districts.

Furthermore on inspection by Entomologists/ DDHS it is found that Aedes mosquito breeding sources are present in cement tanks, buckets, water drums in toilets, Syntex tanks, broken containers, school building construction sites and construction sites/ scraps near the schools. Chief Educational Officers of the above-mentioned districts are requested to instruct all school Headmasters/ Headmistresses to ensure that there are no breeding sources in and around their schools.

District Chief Educational Officers, District Educational Officers and Block level officials with the support of local bodies and public health field staff should ensure that there are no Aedes mosquito breeding in and around the schools.

Once again, all the District Chief Educational Officers, District Educational Officers and Block Development officers are requested to ensure safety of school children & proper instructions should be given to all school Headmasters/ Headmistresses in your district.
