Further Chief Educational Officers shall be instructed to submit utilization certificate in respect of the amount sanctioned under Girls incentive scheme for previous years in consultation with officials of District Adi-draavidar Welfare Department to ensure prompt delivery of the benefits under this Scheme and to settle the Accountant General's audit Objections.

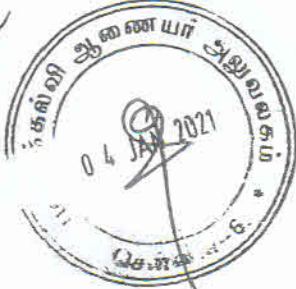

I am directed to invite your kind attention to the reference cited (Copy Enclosed).

In order to ascertain the demand for 2020-2021 under Girl children incentive scheme implemented by this department, your department was requested to provide the Educational Management Information System (EMIS) data available with your department for the years 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 in MS-Excel application software in prescribed format.

Further your department was requested to instruct all headmasters/block educational officers under your control to take

efforts to open a savings bank account in scheduled banks for all the eligible beneficiaries wherever necessary to carry out Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode of disbursement under Girls Incentive Scheme. Your department was also requested to instruct the head masters / block educational officers to submit utilization certificate in respect of the amount sanctioned under Girls incentive scheme for previous years in consultation with district Adi dravidar welfare officers of our department to ensure prompt delivery of the benefits under the scheme and to settle the Accountant General's audit objections.

But no reply has been received from your department so far. Therefore, I am directed to request you to share the EMIS data and copy of the instructions issued to the headmasters/ block educational officers' of your department.

With reference to the letter cited, the copy of the letter is communicated for necessary action.

2. In this regard this is to inform that, girls incentive scheme being implemented by Adi Dravidar Welfare Department with the objective of reducing the dropouts and increasing the Enrollment of the Adi Dravidar and Tribal Girls students and thus helping to continue their studies from III to VIII standard.

As per the scheme provisions, incentive will be given to girl children for pursuing their studies from III standard to VIII standard in Govt./Govt.aided institutions irrespective of their annual income. The value of incentive given under the scheme is tabulated below.

Standard	Incentive amount rate Per month Rs.	No. of months	Total value of incentive per annum Rs.
III to V	50	10	500
VI	100	10	1000
VII and VIII	150	10	1500

Some of the guidelines issued from the Commissioner Adi Dravidar Welfare Department are as follows :

“Several audit objections have been raised on the implementation of the scheme. The core of the audit objections can be attributed to the following two reasons :

1. Non disbursement of incentive to the girls students and the funds allocated for this purpose is kept idle at various levels i.e., institution level / block level / District level.
2. Non submission of utilization certificate (UC) by the institution after disbursing the incentive to the beneficiaries.

It is pointed out that the solution to the audit objections could be resolved if the disbursement under the scheme using direct benefit transfer (DBT) mode. Though this department has instructed to credit the incentive amount to the students' postal / bank account. But, it was brought to the notice of this department that the amount sanctioned by the district officers were kept undisbursed at the Headmaster / block educational officer / District Adi dravidar welfare officers concerned bank account."

Hence, all Chief Educational Officers instructed to strictly follow the above instructions and it has to be brought to the notice of the All District Educational Officers , Block Educational Officers under your control.
